

## Bon-bons Ornament, by Edwina Sutherland

There are two body choices - a three-part body and a four-part body.

### **Three-part body**

Cut out 3 body sections. Join 2 sections right sides together with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Join on the third section.

### **Four-part body**

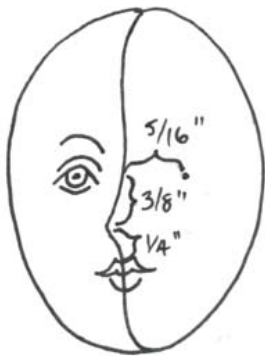
Cut out 4 body sections. Join 2 sections right sides together with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Join the remaining 2 sections together, then place these two halves together and join.

### **All styles**

Trim the seams and turn the body right sides out. Stuff and gather the top edge by hand. Draw it closed and secure the thread.

### **Head**

Stitch around the head with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, using a short stitch length to strengthen the seam. Stuff the head firmly, keeping a good nose shape. Sew the head onto the body by hand.



### **Face**

To find the eye placement, insert 2 pins  $\frac{3}{8}$ " above the nose tip and  $\frac{5}{16}$ " from the center seam. Draw around the pin heads to mark the pupils with a fine pencil, then draw the iris around the pupils. Remove pins and draw an arch over the irises for the lids. Draw a second arch above these for the lid creases, and then add the eyebrows. Draw in the lower lid.

Draw in the mouth, placing the top of the lip  $\frac{1}{4}$ " below the nose tip. Colour the eyes, cheeks and lips with pencils, pens, etc.

Add a **collar** of gathered lace trim.

Cut out the **hat** using the pattern or drawing around a CD. Gather by hand around the circle, about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the edge. Draw up to fit the head. Insert a small amount of stuffing under the hat to keep the shape. Sew the hat to the head

Add a tassel to the lower tip of the body. Add trim and a hanging loop, sewing through the hat to secure it to the head.

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
